In 2004 TDM was honored with the “Award of Excellence” from the Community College Facilities Coalition (“CCFC”) of the Professional Design Awards Program. The new 105,000 SF, 4-story Technology Center building including a full basement houses nine departments that were integrated into the Technology Center in the largest building on campus. This allowed the college to remove numerous were housed in old and dilapidated bungalows.

The Technology Center provides a centralized, accessible and technologically advanced facility. It houses computer age coursework that provides tools for students to maintain a competitive edge in a rapidly changing technical workplace. The five-level structure meets the College’s demand for technological upgrades in fields such as Architecture, Engineering, Computer Sciences, Information Technology and Electronics.
