This 98,000 square foot project is a new Elementary School for Kindergarten through Eighth grade with 35 classrooms, a library, a multi-purpose room and a full kitchen. It is constructed on a steeply sloping site in the Echo Park area of Los Angeles and includes over a full underground parking structure. The design theme is based upon Brio blocks and is designed to create the atmosphere of an educational village scaled for small children. Partnering with the City of Los Angeles, a 2,500 SF neighborhood senior center was added to the scope early on. The project also achieved a CHPS score of 35.
